What is the Practice Membership Plan?

Our Practice Membership Plan offers a simple, flexible way to pay for your dental care. In return for a monthly or annual payment we provide you with a comprehensive programme of maintenance, prevention and treatment.

Why have we introduced the Practice Membership Plan?

We are totally committed to providing all of our patients with the best quality dental care. We want to be able to spend more time with our patients and provide prompt treatment using the latest techniques and the best quality materials. We want to be proactive about your dental health and for this reason regular oral hygiene visits are included in our Practice Membership Plan as well as your regular routine examinations. Regular oral hygiene visits are essential to keep your breath fresh and to prevent gum disease. You may have very healthy teeth but if your gums and the supporting structures are not healthy you run the risk of losing teeth and perhaps contracting infections which in turn can cause complications such as heart disease and diabetes. This combined preventative programme is proven to be the best way of ensuring long term dental health. Over time, patients who participate in a preventative programme of regular exams and oral hygiene visits, such as those offered by our Practice Membership Plan, are shown to have a much reduced need for treatment.

Why should I become a member?

Membership ensures you have access to quality dental care, offers you a simple flexible way to pay for your dental care and is designed to encourage you to visit us regularly. Our 71 Club is ideal for those people who only require occasional examinations and sometimes cleaning as well as the added bonus of insurance against dental accidents/traumas.

Do I need to be dentally fit to join?

No, there is only one rate for everyone regardless of the problems you may have suffered in the past. You are not assessed on the state of your mouth and you do not have to undertake any expensive courses of treatment in order to be accepted.

How do I join?

Take a few minutes to fill in a simple form at reception and then sit back while we do the rest. You can be secure in the knowledge that your dental health is safe with us.

What is included in the Plan?

- One examination per year *
- Either one hygiene visit or one home visit
- X-rays where necessary
- Free denture repairs **
- Discount off denture relines
- Discount off new dentures

The Practice Membership Plan is not an insurance scheme, but for an additional £2 per month or £24 per year, you can benefit from our dental accident & emergency insurance.

What is the dental accident & emergency insurance?

We offer this insurance to pay for the cost of dental treatment required if you damage your teeth as a result of an accident, or need a dentist out of hours or in an emergency.

This insurance covers you up to £10,000, anywhere in the world for:

- Accidental damage to your teeth *** as the result of a fall or blow
- Worldwide cover for emergency treatment, for toothache, abscesses etc.
- Lime Tree Dental Practice Out Of Hours Emergency Call Out service. We run our own dental emergency service. Members get to see one of our dentists, at Lime Tree and the call out is FREE OF CHARGE.

What is the cost of the Practice Membership Plan?

Annual payment (to Lime Tree Dental Practice) £72

If you wish to take out the optional insurance, this can be done by either;
